Mission Statement:

To work across class, cultural and geographic lines in New Orleans to develop a transportation policy for the region that is ecologically sustainable, community-oriented, accessible for a diverse usage, affordable to all residents, efficient and prompt, safe for riders (as well as non-riders), and democratically controlled.

Current Goals:

- To establish quality shelters and up-to-date bus schedules at all major stops
- To establish city-wide bicycle lanes and infrastructure
- To equip all RTA busses with bicycle racks
- To establish regional light rail
- To incorporate community-based planning as a primary tool of transit design

Current Projects:

- Gathering 1,000 signatures for shelters and schedules at all major bus stops
- Preparing our **Five Point Plan to Improve Transportation in New Orleans**
- Planning a “Sustainable Transit Forum” featuring Karen Parsons of the Regional Planning Commission, representatives from City Planning, RTA, and each of the coalition partners
- Preparing presentation for meetings with Mayor’s office, RTA, City Planning and other relevant agencies
